Whereas, The Ramsey County Board is committed to a fair and open elections process; and

Whereas, The County Board views Instant Runoff Voting as a mechanism that can be used to ensure citizens the right to have their votes counted; Now, Therefore, Be It

Resolved, The Ramsey County Board of Commissioners, based on their review of this item, supports the concept that would allow local units of government to use Instant Runoff Voting as an alternative voting method in local elections.
